Medicine, Scientific specialty: "Gastroenterology" for the needs of Gastroenterology Clinic at Acibadem City Clinic Tokuda University General Hospital, announced in SG at 12/11.02.2025.

The teaching, academic work, research and publication activity of Assoc. Prof. Dr. Petko Karagyozov were assessed according to the requirements of Art. 4, para. 2 and Art. 29a of the Academic Staff Development Act, Art. 2, para. 2 and para. 3, Art. 62, para. 1 and para. 2 of the Implementing Regu; ations of the Academic Staff Development Act, Art. 67 of the Regulations for the Development of the Academic Staff at Acibadem City Clinic Tokuda University General Hospital.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Petko Karagyozov was born on 08.08.1979 in the town of Sevlievo. He completed his secondary education at the High School for Foreign Languages «Ekzarch Yosid I» – Lovech in 1998. He received his higher education in "Medicine" at the Medical University – Sofia in 2004. He specialized in "Internal Medicine" and "Gastroenterology" at the Military Medical Academy - Sofia from 2005 to 2010. He obtained the specialty "Gastroenterology" at the Medical University - Sofia, in 2013. In the period 2017 – 2020 he was a doctoral student at the Clinic of Gastroenterology and Pulmonology at Acibadem City Clinic Tokuda University General Hospital, Sofia. He defended his educational and scientific degree "Doctor" in the scientific specialty "Internal Medicine" in 2020 at the Scientific Organization Acibadem City Clinic Tokuda University General Hospital. He received a master's degree in public health and healthcare management at the Medical University - Plovdiv in 2016.

Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov started working in 2006 as a resident physician at the Clinic of Gastroenterology and Hepatology, Military Medical Academy – Sofia and worked as such until 2011. In the period 2009 – 2011 he was also an officer of the Bulgarian Army. In 2011 he became a physician at the Department of Gastroenterology at the Clinic of Gastroenterology and Pulmonology, Tokuda Hospital Sofia. In 2015 he became Head of the Interventional Gastroenterology Department at the Clinic of Gastroenterology and Pulmonology at Acibadem City Clinic Tokuda University General Hospital and in 2017 he was appointed Head of the Department at the Clinic of Gastroenterology and Pulmonology at Acibadem City Clinic Tokuda University General Hospital. Since 2019, he has been a part-time lecturer at the Faculty of Medicine of Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridski". In 2022, he was elected as an associate professor at the Scientific Organization Acibadem City Clinic Tokuda University General Hospital, Sofia.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Petko Karagyozov holds certificates of professional qualification, namely: Conventional ultrasound - abdominal ultrasound and surface structures - level one; Abdominal Doppler ultrasound - level two; Interventional and endoscopic ultrasound - level three. Conventional gastrointestinal endoscopy with biopsy level one.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Petko Karagyozov has specializations in gastrointestinal endoscopy, ERCP, endoscopic ultrasound at Shonan Karakura Hospital, Okamoto, Japan and Elisabethinen Hospital, Linz, Austria. He has completed training in «Endoscopic Resection with FTRD System» in Stuttgart, Germany; «Endoscopy Trainer Program» in Rome, Italy; ERCP and Cholangiopancreatoscopy - training in Jablonec, Czech Republic and Jerusalem, Israel; training in upper endoscopy and abdominal ultrasound in Dresden, Germany. He has completed courses in «Basic Techniques for Endoscopic Mucosal Dissection» in Hamburg, Germany; «Percutaneous Biliary Interventions» in Amsterdam, Netherlands; «Fundamentals of Effective Colonoscopy» in Hamburg, Germany; Gastroenterology Course in Amsterdam, Netherlands.

He is fluent in written and spoken English and German. He has excellent computer literacy and uses the most innovative communication technologies.

Teaching workload of Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov at the Faculty of Economics of Sofia University "St. Kliment Ogridski" is calculated at 1528 academic hours for the last five academic years (2019-2024 inclusive), which is an average of 305.6 academic hours per year.

Acibadem City Clinic Tokuda University General Hospital proves that Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov has 1415 academic hours workload with residents.

The total number of points for scientific activity (Groups of indicators from A, B, D, E) is 4638.16 points with a minimum required of 550 points.

Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov is participating in an intra-university scientific project at MU-Plovdiv with No. NO-14/2024 and with the title: "Endoscopic ligament ligation of esophageal varices and placement of an esophageal prosthesis on a porcine model – techniques, benefits, risks."

Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov has acquired 1 specialty - gastroenterology.

The main scientific contributions of Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov are related to digital oral cholangiopancreatoscopy (DOCP) and its place in the diagnosis and treatment of pancreaticobiliary diseases. This is a new methodology for the country and as such creates the opportunity for new algorithms of behavior in diseases of the pancreaticobiliary system. Echoendoscopic biliary drainage is a methodology developed and applied in the country for the first time by Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov. Such are also echoendoscopic pancreaticogastrostomy, echoendoscopic gastroenteroanastomosis, endoscopic ultrasound in liver diseases (endohepatology), endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography, combined with endoscopic ultrasound. Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov is also actively developing topics related to iatrogenic lesions of the bile ducts, endoscopic treatment of peripancreatic pseudocysts and necrotic collections (WOPN), as well as complex interventions under endosonographic control, endoscopic papillectomy, endoscopic therapy of perforations and fistulas. All this currently makes Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov one of the best multifunctional gastroenterologists-endoscopists in the country with worldwide recognition.

Assoc. Prof. Petko Karagyozov has 18 years of work experience, of which 13.5 years of work experience in Acibadem City Clinic Tokuda University General Hospital.
