The actual scientific publications in scientific journals are 78. The participation in scientific forums is 77, as 53 are national and 24 are abroad. The total number of citations is 37, as 20 are in the Republic of Bulgaria and 17 abroad. The impact factor is 5,174. The thematic directions in the scientific works of Assoc. Prof. Dr. Demerdzhieva are in the field of dermatology and ophthalmology. The presented scientific papers point to the following areas in the scientific and professional interests of the candidate: • The dissertation on "Syphilis and systemic dermatoses - changes in lymph and blood vessels" was developed under the scientific guidance of Art. cor. Prof. Dr. Nikolai Tsankov.
